On April 2, Scientific Games of Alpharetta, Ga., requested copies of: technical proposal submissions, all pricing proposals, all current vendor contracts and any amendments related to Iowa Lottery RFP IL 12-02 for instant-scratch ticket printing and related services. On April 29, the Iowa Lottery shipped to Scientific Games a flash drive containing the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On April 22, Northwestern University in Evanston, III., requested annual lottery sales from Dec. 20, 2015, to the present, with sales broken out by Iowa Lottery retail location and product type for instant-scratch, pull-tab and InstaPlay games, with sales for lotto games broken out by game name. The university also requested information about the date that a product began sales, where applicable. In addition, for the time period of July 1, 2018, to the present, the university requested information about all lotto prizes of \$600 or more claimed from the Iowa Lottery, including the prize amount, drawing date, and retail location where the winning ticket was purchased. On May 9, the Iowa Lottery provided the requested information via a Google Drive folder. There was no charge for this request.

On April 26, My Payment Source in Washington, D.C. requested a copy of Iowa Lottery annuity winners from 2016 to the present along with details for that same timeframe regarding all Iowa Lottery games with an annuity option for prize claims and information about how an annuity is paid out; and any news releases or court orders of assignment of lottery payments.
