MINUTES IOWA LOTTERY COMMISSION

June 24, 2025 10:30 a.m.

The Iowa Lottery Commission convened at 10:30 a.m. at Lottery's main office in Clive; Commission Chair Dana Wingert presiding.

CALL TO ORDER

Wingert called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. and roll was taken. There was a quorum. Wingert announced the meeting would be held via teleconference in accordance with lowa Code section 21.8.

Cook moved to conduct the meeting via teleconference. Rathje seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Cook moved to approve the agenda for the meeting. Rathje seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Cook moved to approve the March 25, 2025 commission meeting minutes. Rathje seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

CEO REPORT

Strawn stated that as the lowa Lottery enters its 40th year, it can be described as a "legacy brand" built over many years. As trustees of that legacy, the lowa Lottery will meet and exceed its forecasted budget projections for both lottery sales and proceeds as FY25 draws to a close. Through May 2025, total lottery sales of \$400,986,731 are 4.61% – or \$17.7 million - ahead of budget projections for the fiscal year; and total lottery proceeds of \$81,063,349 are 14.33% – or \$10.1 million - ahead of budget projections for the fiscal year. Notwithstanding national lotto headwinds, the fact that the lowa Lottery will meet and exceed its revenue targets for FY25 is a testament to an amazing Lottery team who continue to honor the lowa Lottery's legacy.

The work that has been done getting us to 40 years is not enough to sustain a legacy brand like the Iowa Lottery -- legacy brands don't evolve by doing what's always worked. So the Iowa Lottery's product categories will need to continue to evolve.

Strawn closed his report by publicly recognizing Mary Neubauer, a member of the lottery's executive management team, as she prepares to retire after 25 years of service to the lowa Lottery. Mary truly embodies what it means to "leave a legacy". We deeply appreciate her dedication and contributions to the lowa Lottery, the State of lowa, and other great causes over the years that have benefitted from her service. I am grateful for her leadership, her friendship, and her being a trusted and valued colleague to so many of us here at the Lottery.

QUARTERLY REPORTS

Revenue (Sales and Marketing):

Roth gave a Revenue report. Roth provided further detail on Iowa Lottery sales and how the lottery's performance compares to the lottery industry. When compared to FY24, FY25 sales continue to be lower due in large part to lower jackpots for Powerball and Mega Millions so far in FY25. On an overall basis through the end of May, revenues are \$401 million, exceeding the budget by 4.6%. On a year-over-year basis compared to FY24, sales experienced a decrease of 12.2%. On a fiscal year to date basis, the industry continues to be down by (6.3%) vs. the previous year, with some areas of the country now experiencing better performance.

<u>Lotto Category</u>: Overall, we have seen a decrease of 34.9% for the Lotto Category for FY24 through May. Powerball sales of \$35m have experienced a decrease of 52.7% vs. FY24, and Mega Millions with sales of \$26m has experienced a 30.9% decrease vs. FY24. With the lower cost margin on these games, the decreases in sales this fiscal year also have a significant impact in decreasing proceeds.

In April, the new Mega Millions game was launched and the Iowa Lottery is seeing an increase in sales of roughly 6% when comparing similar jackpot runs in order to fully assess the performance of the new game. Conversely, Lotto America with its second highest jackpot won recently is up by 35.3% with sales of \$8.4 million.

<u>Scratch Tickets</u>: In lowa, sales of scratch-tickets have experienced a decrease in sales of 4.2% through the end of May for FY25. On a fiscal YTD basis, scratch-ticket performance for the industry has experienced a slight decline of 0.5%; with certain states in the west and south starting to make positive increases in sales.

<u>InstaPlay</u>: The lowa Lottery is experiencing very positive sales results in FY25 for InstaPlay. In September at the start of the lottery's game updates, InstaPlay sales of \$6.1 million were down 7.8% through the end of the month. As of the end of May, sales of \$28.8 million were up by 11.6% for FY25 vs. FY24.

<u>Pull-Tabs</u>: Pull-Tab sales continue to be strong with sales of \$13.4 million, or a 14.6% increase vs. FY24 through May.

Roth also shared that the Iowa Lottery has several current and planned promotions, including: Powerball NASACAR at the Iowa Speedway. The promotion performed well, but not as strong as last year when the promotion also experienced a large jackpot run. In early June, the Jurassic World, and Scratch, Match & Win Promotions were launched.

- The Jurassic World promotion features a Jurassic World themed scratch-ticket and a Jurassic Park themed InstPlay game. Sales for the both tickets are off to a good start.
- The Scratch, Match & Win is a 40th anniversary game that celebrates the first scratch-ticket sold by the lowa Lottery.

In July, we'll launch promotions for Iowa State Cyclone Football and a chance to win a suite experience at Jack Trice Stadium. And in August, we'll launch a promotion for the University of Iowa with a new "Hawkeye Blackout" scratch-ticket that will be the entry for a chance to win seats in the Ironmen Suite at Kinnick stadium as well as a chance to win cash.

Roth concluded his report by giving an update on the performance of self-serve kiosks that were approved in FY23. The kiosks have contributed significantly to overall sales and their performance is on track with initial projections.

External Relations:

Neubauer gave an External Relations report. Neubauer said the lowa Lottery has applied for a Level 2 certification in responsible gaming from the World Lottery Association (WLA). The WLA offers 4 levels of RG certification and the lottery currently has a Level 1 certification. In the Level 2 self-assessment, 99 questions across 10 areas of emphasis must be answered. The lowa Lottery submitted its certification application on April 25, 2025. If a Level 2 certification is awarded from the WLA, it will remain in effect until May 2028.

Neubauer also stated that the External Relations team has worked on rewriting the responsible gaming information on the lottery's website. The "Know Before You Play" webpage has taken information that was in 2 sections on the lottery's website and combined the information to just 1 page with 8 topics.

Neubauer concluded her report by sharing that the use of organic content on lottery social media posts continues. This less-formal approach has been well received.

Security:

Waymire's Security report was provided in the commission packet and there were no change to the submitted report.

Finance:

Podrebarac gave a Finance report. Through May, YTD sales are \$401 million. The YTD sales are ahead of budget by \$17.7 million, or 4.6%. YTD sales are behind sales for the same period of FY24 by \$55.9 million, or 12.2%; predominantly due to the lack of high jackpots in national lotto games.

Through May, YTD proceeds are \$81.1 million. The YTD proceeds are ahead of budget by \$10.2 million, or 14.3%. YTD proceeds are behind proceeds for FY24 by \$20.6M, or 20.3%.

Through May, YTD prize expense is \$260.4 million. The YTD prize expense is ahead of budget by \$18 million, or 7.4%. YTD prize expense is behind prize expense for FY24 by \$30.8 million, or 10.6%. Remember that as sales decrease, prize expense also decreases.

YTD operating expenses through May remain under budget at \$13.7 million.

FY26 BUDGET OVERVIEW

Roth provided an overview of the FY26 budget. Overall, the lottery continued with a conservative approach to budgeting in order to continue to meet or exceed budgeted sales and proceeds. The budget does not include any impact as a result of the RFP for ticket printing and loyalty program services. Any adjustments to be made will be done once the evaluation process, contract negotiation, and implementation efforts are completed.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULES UPDATES

Waldmeier discussed the proposed changes related to Administrative Rules. The department is undergoing its final year of modernization Rollout 5 to allow lottery appeals to be processed in the GovConnectIowa and IMPACT systems. Therefore, two rules need to be amended.

Cook moved to approve the proposed administrative rules changes. Rathje seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Rathje moved to approve Katie New as Commission Chair and Josh Cook as Commission Vice-Chair for FY26. Cook seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

FY 2026 COMMISSION MEETINGS DATE

Dates were set for quarterly meetings in FY26.

OTHER BUSINESS – RESOLUTION

Chair Wingert read a resolution in recognition and appreciation of Mary Neubauer's 25 years of distinguished service to the State of Iowa and the Iowa Lottery.

Cook moved to adopt the resolution (attached). Rathje seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT

Cook moved to adjourn. Rathje seconded. Motion carried unanimously.



- H. The Ticket Validation Number and the Pack Ticket Numbers shall be printed in black ink.
- I. The Ticket must have been issued by the Lottery in an authorized manner.
- J. The Ticket must not be stolen nor appear on any list of omitted Tickets on file at the Lottery.
- K. The Prize Symbols, Play Symbols and captions, Ticket Validation Number and Pack Ticket Numbers must be right side up and not reversed in any manner.
- L. The Ticket Validation Number of an apparent winning Ticket shall appear on the Lottery's official list of Ticket Validation Numbers of winning Tickets; and a Ticket with that Ticket Validation Number shall not have been paid previously.
- M. The Ticket must not be blank or partially blank, misregistered, defective, or printed or produced in error.
- N. The Game Play Area Symbols must be exactly as described in Section 3.6 above.
- O. Each of the Play Symbols and captions on the Ticket must be printed in the symbol font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery; each of the Legends must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery; the Pack Ticket Numbers must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery; and the Ticket Validation Number must be printed in the Ticket validation font and must correspond precisely to the artwork on file at the Lottery.
- P. The display printing must be regular in every respect and correspond precisely with the artwork on file at the Lottery.
- Q. The Ticket must pass all additional requirements stated in these game specific rules and any confidential validation requirements established by the Lottery.
- 4.3 A Ticket which fails any of the Lottery's validation checks is invalid and ineligible for any prize. The Administrator may replace an invalid Ticket with an unplayed Ticket from the same game or any other game. If an invalid or defective Ticket is purchased or lawfully obtained, the only responsibility or liability of the Administrator shall be the replacement of the defective Ticket with an unplayed Ticket from the same game or any other game, or a refund of the sales price of the Ticket. By purchasing or lawfully obtaining a Ticket, a player agrees to the terms of these game specific rules, including but not limited to the limitation of remedy for an invalid or defective Ticket.

SECTION 5 - INSTANT TICKET CLAIM PERIOD AND TICKET RESPONSIBILITY

- All game prizes must be claimed within ninety (90) days of the announced end of the game. All mailed prize claims must be sent to the official mailing address available at ialottery.com, and received by the Lottery prior to the expiration of the claim period set forth above. Any prize not claimed within the period specified herein or in the manner specified on the back of each Ticket shall be forfeited. In the event the last day to claim a prize falls on a Saturday, a Sunday, or a legal holiday, the time to claim shall be extended to the close of business on the next day thereafter when Lottery offices are open for business. The Lottery reserves the right to require the claimant to claim a prize in person, including but not limited to when the claimant is legally required to fill out tax forms in order to claim the prize.
- 5.2 A Ticket is a bearer instrument until signed on the back by the owner.
- 5.3 The Lottery shall not be responsible for lost or stolen Tickets.
- 5.4 The Lottery shall not be responsible for Tickets lost in the mail, mailed to an incorrect address or mailed to an address other than the addresses specified by the Lottery to receive prize claims, or for Tickets not received by the Lottery before the expiration of the claim period set forth in these game specific rules.
- 5.5 The Lottery shall not be responsible for Tickets claimed by a player in error for a lower prize at a Retailer.
