

## **Open Records Information Provided By The Iowa Lottery In May 2012**

**(On average, responses were provided within 3 calendar days.)**

On May 1, Peachtree Settlement Funding of Boynton Beach, Fla., requested a list of all Iowa Lottery winners who had won an annuity (in any amount) from any type of game from Jan. 1, 2012, to the present. That same day, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On May 8, Gerald Duncan of Omaha, Neb., requested a list of new applications to sell lottery tickets in the cities of Council Bluffs, Glenwood and Denison from April 1 through May 5, 2012. That same day, the Iowa Lottery asked Mr. Duncan to clarify his request. Later that afternoon, Mr. Duncan clarified that he was seeking information about whether there had been new lottery license applications at four specific addresses in southwest Iowa. On May 9, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On May 9, BOFI Federal Bank of San Diego, Calif, requested information about the prize amount won, number of payments and game involved for Sharon Points Ruback. That same day, the Iowa Lottery requested that the bank clarify its request, which it did that afternoon. On May 18 and May 21, the Iowa Lottery provided two emails with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.

On May 10, Seneca One Finance of Bethesda, Md., requested a list of all Iowa Lottery annuity winners from January 2012 to the present along with court orders for annuity assignments and updates on deceased or divorced annuitants along with beneficiary information from the same timeframe. That same day, the Iowa Lottery provided one email with the requested information. There was no charge for this request.
