

NASCAR® in Iowa & The Chase to \$1M Promotion Rules

The NASCAR® in Iowa & The Chase to \$1M Promotion is an Iowa Lottery VIP Club™ web-based Play It Again® promotion offering a total of 75 prizes (74 NASCAR race experiences at Iowa Speedway August 7-9, 2026 and 1 prize of \$10,000 including the Iowa Lottery semi-finalist entry for the national NASCAR Powerball – The Chase to \$1 Million).

The Iowa Lottery promotion, which can be entered by members of the VIP Club with eligible Iowa Lottery Powerball® tickets begins at 10:00 a.m. Central Time (CT) Thursday, May 7, with entries accepted through 9:59 a.m. CT on Tuesday, August 11, 2026.

NASCAR in Iowa & The Chase to \$1M promotion prizes are subject to lottery rules, validation procedures, set-offs and deductions authorized by law. The Iowa Speedway race weekend prize packages include the required state and federal income tax withholding paid on the value of the prize package. There is no all-cash option for the race weekend prize packages. Iowa Lottery will withhold all state and federal taxes as may be required by law. The winners are responsible for all other taxes that may be due and owing.

Entry

To enter, an individual must be a current member of the IA Lottery VIP Club™ or join prior to entering. Entrants must legally acquire and submit a winning or nonwinning Iowa Powerball ticket purchased on or after May 7, 2026 with a \$2 or more value.

Submission for the promotion is as follows: During the entry period, entrants first log in to their VIP Club account on the Iowa Lottery website, ialottery.com. Following login, entrants click the promotions screen and manually enter the 21-digit number from the front of the Powerball ticket. Entrants can also scan and enter the eligible Powerball tickets with the Iowa Lottery LotteryPlus mobile app after logging in to the VIP Club.

Each winning or nonwinning Powerball ticket entered will receive one entry in the promotion category of the player's choice for either the VIP Suite prize package or the Grandstand prize package during the first entry period, and in the second entry period for the \$10,000 cash and Iowa Lottery semi-finalist entry in the national NASCAR Powerball - The Chase.

Players can enter multiple Powerball tickets, but an eligible Powerball ticket can be entered only once. Each Powerball ticket entered will receive one entry in the promotion, regardless of the purchase price or the number of plays on the ticket. Entrants must follow the VIP Club rules. Players must use a street address in their account information – P.O. boxes are not valid for this promotion or the VIP Club.

Eligibility

An eligible entry is any legally acquired winning or nonwinning Iowa Lottery Powerball ticket purchased on or after May 7, 2026 that has not been previously submitted on the Iowa Lottery LotteryPlus app or through the Iowa Lottery website as an entry into this promotion or any other promotion. All entrants must be 21 years of age or older. A person can only win one prize package per drawing category. However, an entrant cannot win both a VIP Race Weekend Suite Experience and a Grandstand Race Weekend prize package. If an entrant is selected as a winner of both prize packages, the entrant will be awarded the prize with the higher prize value and the prize package with the lower value will be awarded to an alternate. Winners of a VIP Race Weekend Suite Experience or Grandstand Race Weekend prize package can also win the \$10,000 cash and the Iowa Lottery semi-finalist entry in the national NASCAR Powerball – The Chase promotion. All entries for the first entry period that were not selected as a winner of a race prize package, will be eligible and automatically roll into the drawing on August 12, 2026 for the cash prize and Iowa Lottery semi-finalist entry in the national NASCAR Powerball – The Chase promotion.

Except as provided under the “Iowa Lottery Chief Executive Officer’s Discretion” section below, an eligible entry is one in which the entry information is completed and submitted electronically during the posted entry time, as specified on the Iowa Lottery website. Players may attempt to enter this promotion up to 40 times per day through their VIP Club account. Both valid entries and invalid submissions (e.g. duplicate submissions, submission of ineligible tickets, submissions containing incorrect information, etc.) count toward the 40-entry-per-day limit. The Iowa Lottery is not responsible for otherwise eligible entries that are entered inaccurately, incorrectly, or arrive after 9:59 a.m. Tuesday, August 11, 2026.

Players who have signed up for the Iowa Lottery self-exclusion program are not eligible to participate in this promotion. Members of the Iowa Lottery Commission, Iowa Department of Revenue officers and employees, other employees of the State of Iowa who provide services in support of the Iowa Lottery Division and who have access to confidential information that may compromise the integrity of the Iowa Lottery, and their immediate families, as defined by statute, are not eligible to participate in this promotion. Further, officers, employees, agents or subcontractors of any vendor who have access to confidential information that may compromise the integrity of the Iowa Lottery, and their immediate families, as defined by statute, are not eligible to participate in this promotion.

Drawings

The Iowa Lottery drawings for the NASCAR in Iowa & The Chase to \$1M promotion will be held on Wednesday, July 15, 2026 and Wednesday, August 12, 2026. The Lottery will use a random-number generator to select the winners and alternates. The Iowa Lottery drawings will be held in accordance with the schedule posted to the Iowa Lottery’s website (ialottery.com) and listed in the promotion rules.

The drawings will be held under the supervision of an independent auditor. All drawings of the Iowa Lottery are public events. Persons interested in observing drawings are invited to receive detailed information by contacting the Iowa Lottery Security Division by telephone at (515) 725-7900, by TTY Relay Iowa at (800) 735-2942, or by email directed to WMaster@ialottery.com. A request to observe a drawing must be received by the Iowa Lottery no later than seven days in advance of the drawing. All drawings are recorded.

The winners’ names will be posted on the Lottery’s website by the end of the day following the draw day or as soon as practicable following the determination of the winners. The winners will be sent an email to their VIP Club member email address with instructions for claiming their prize. Entrants are not required to personally attend the drawings or be present at the time of the drawings to win. Each of the selected numbers will be verified against the numbers entered in the promotion. A sufficient number of entries will be randomly selected to ensure there are valid winners for the prizes to be announced.

In order to claim their prize, winners must complete and sign an Iowa Lottery Winner Claim Form, along with appropriate tax documentation, and present those documents with a legible copy of their government-issued photo identification to the Iowa Lottery by 4 p.m. on July 29, 2026 for the Race Weekend prize packages and by 4 p.m. on August 19, 2026 for the \$10,100 and Iowa Lottery semi-finalist entry.

By submitting an entry into the promotion and claiming a prize, the entrant certifies they are the owner of the entry, the entrant is at least 21 years old, the ticket was not stolen or acquired illegally, and the entrant is not disqualified

from receiving a prize. By entering the promotion, the entrant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Department of Revenue, and the State of Iowa, its elected officials, apprentices, employees, agents, and volunteers, and NASCAR, LLC, Iowa Speedway, LLC (collectively the "Released Parties"). In consideration for participating in the promotion, the entrant waives any and all claims the entrant may have or ever claim to have against the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Department of Revenue, and the State of Iowa, its employees, agents, or commission members, relating in any way to the promotion. The player also consents to the use by the Iowa Lottery and the Iowa Department of Revenue of their name or likeness for advertising, trade, or promotional purposes without further compensation.

By accepting a NASCAR in Iowa & the Chase to \$1M promotion prize, the winner and their heirs, legal representatives, and assigns agree to indemnify, defend, release, and discharge the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Department of Revenue, and each of their employees, officers, and directors from and against any loss, claim, damage, suit, or injury arising out of or relating to the promotion or any action taken pursuant to these rules. The Iowa Lottery, Iowa Department of Revenue, and the State of Iowa are not responsible or liable, in any way, for any personal injuries, illness, death, property damage, or other damages or expense resulting from or arising out of acceptance, fulfillment, use, or misuse of the promotion prize or any element thereof.

The Multi-State Lottery Association will conduct the NASCAR Powerball – The Chase drawings to award the cash prizes of up to the \$1 million in the national promotion. Each participating jurisdiction will send one semi-finalist to the national promotion and these semi-finalists will be announced Sunday, September 6, 2026 during the race at Darlington Speedway in Darlington, SC. The Iowa Lottery is providing an additional \$8,000 for the Iowa Lottery semi-finalist winner for a total prize of \$10,000.

NASCAR Powerball – The Chase drawings and prizes will be revealed during select races and broadcasts. There will be four Multi-State Lottery Association drawings and announcement dates in the national promotion.

- September 17, 2026 – announced during the race at Kansas Motor Speedway in Kansas City, Kansas. Twenty (20) national semi-finalists win \$3,000.
- October 18, 2026 – announced at the Phoenix Raceway in Phoenix, Arizona. Ten (10) national semi-finalists win \$5,000.
- November 1, 2026 – announced at Martinsville Speedway in Martinsville, Virginia. Four (4) national finalists win \$10,000 and VIP Trip to the 2026 NASCAR Cup Series Championship™ Race Homestead Miami Speedway®.
- November 8, 2026 – announced at Homestead Miami Speedway in Homestead, Florida. One (1) grand prize winner of \$1 million and three (3) winners of \$10,000.

Participating lottery jurisdictions at the time the Iowa Lottery promotion begins include: Arizona, Delaware, Florida, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Minnesota, Mississippi, Nebraska, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas and Vermont. Additional lotteries may join the national promotion later.

Odds

The odds of winning a NASCAR in Iowa & The Chase to \$1 M promotion prize will vary depending on the number of entries.

Iowa Lottery Chief Executive Officer's Discretion

If the Iowa Lottery Chief Executive Officer (CEO), or the CEO's designee, determines that an otherwise valid entry has been foiled by the intervention of an Iowa Lottery employee, Iowa Lottery retailer, or Iowa Lottery vendor processing error, the CEO may authorize the replacement of an eligible entry. This shall be the player's only recourse against the Iowa Lottery or its personnel.

Force Majeure

If the Iowa Lottery is hindered from providing the prizes due to riots, acts of God, shortages of labor or materials, war, acts of terrorism, government laws, regulations, or restrictions or any other causes of any kind whatsoever which are beyond the reasonable control of the Iowa Lottery, then the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Department of Revenue, and the State of Iowa shall not be liable or responsible for its inability to provide some or all of the prizes discussed herein.

Choice of Law and Forum

The laws of the State of Iowa shall govern and determine all matters arising out of or in connection with this promotion. Any and all litigation commenced in connection with this promotion shall be brought and maintained solely in Polk County District Court for the State of Iowa, Des Moines, Iowa, or in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Iowa, Central Division, Des Moines, Iowa, wherever jurisdiction is appropriate. This provision shall not be

construed as waiving any immunity in state or federal court, which may be available to the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Department of Revenue, or the State of Iowa.
