Check Your Tickets Online: We've Got An App For That!

The Iowa Lottery has an Apple AND an Android version of its app you can use to check the outcome of your Iowa Lottery tickets and get the latest details about games and promotions.



The app is called the "Iowa Lottery's LotteryPlus," and you can find it at the **Google Play Store**® and the **Apple App Store**®.

Supported technology:

- Google Play Store version supports Android 4.1 and above
- iTunes version supports iOS 8.0 and above

Here are some of the functions in the Lottery's official mobile app:

- Check your lotto, InstaPlay or scratch tickets to see if you're a winner and how much you've won using the bar code scanner
- Join the VIP Club, then log in to enter Play It Again® promotions by simply scanning your eligible tickets
- Use the "ePlayslip" feature to design a ticket for your favorite Iowa Lottery lotto game on the go. Pick your favorite numbers or shake your device to use the numbers generator. Saving your play generates a bar code that you can scan at any lottery retailer when you're ready to purchase your ticket
- Get current jackpots and winning numbers for all of the Iowa Lottery's games, including Powerball®, Mega Millions®, Lotto America®, Lucky For Life®, Iowa's Pick 3 and Pick 4 games, and InstaPlay Progressive games
- Find an Iowa Lottery retailer close to you
- Learn about the Iowa Lottery's latest promotions, scratch tickets and more

Check Your Ticket



Find out if your ticket is a winner - fast!
Look for a self-checker or kiosk located at select Iowa Lottery retailers. Use them to check your lotto, InstaPlay and scratch tickets. Just place your ticket under the red light, with the square bar code facing up. You can also use the LotteryPlus app. Don't miss out on a prize - check today!

How To Claim Your Prize

- For **Powerball®**, **Mega Millions®**, **Lotto America®** and **Lucky for Life®** prizes, you have **180** days from the date of the drawing to claim your prize in Iowa.
- For **Pick 3** and **Pick 4** prizes, you have **90** days from the date of the drawing to claim your prize.
- For **InstaPlay** prizes, you have **90** days from the date of purchase to claim your prize.
- For **scratch and pull-tab** games, prizes in Iowa must be claimed within **90** days of the official game end date for that specific game.

You must sign your ticket before it can be checked or cashed.

Prizes of up to \$600 in lotto, scratch and InstaPlay games may be redeemed at any lottery retail location in the state if sufficient funds are available. Pull-tab prizes of up to \$600, however, must be redeemed at the same retail location where the ticket was purchased.

Prizes of more than \$600 may be claimed by visiting an Iowa Lottery office or by mail. However, please note that all prizes of more than \$250,000, as well as some special merchandise prizes, must be claimed in person at the Iowa Lottery headquarters office in Clive. Check ialottery.com for the latest prize-claim procedures.

How to Claim a Prize by Mail:

Complete the name and address information on the back of your ticket and sign the signature line. A parent or guardian must also sign the ticket for any claimant who is a minor. For prizes of \$100 or more, a completed copy of our winner claim form and Federal Tax Form W-9 also are required. For prizes of more than \$600, those two documents are required along with a legible, valid copy of the winner's government-issued photo identification. (Acceptable examples include: driver's license, state I.D. card, military I.D. card, passport or permanent resident card.) Mail the ticket with your completed claim form, Tax Form W-9 and copy of photo I.D. (if applicable) to:

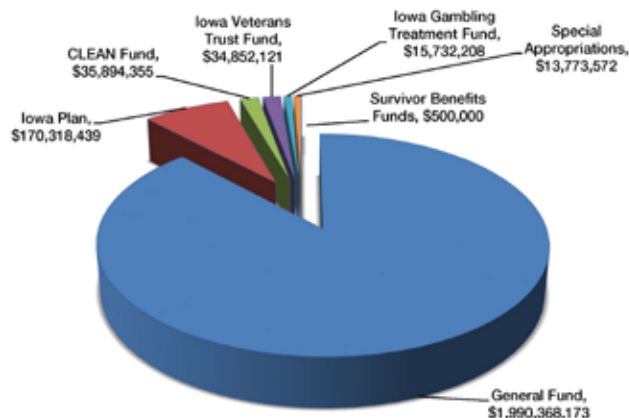

How to Play Powerball®

Powerball is a multi-state game; tickets are sold by 48 U.S. lotteries. Drawings are held at 9:59 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Tickets may be purchased in Iowa until 8:59 p.m. the evening of the drawing.

The starting jackpot and the rate at which the jackpot increases is based upon sales and interest rates, with no fixed minimums. Players have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim a prize.

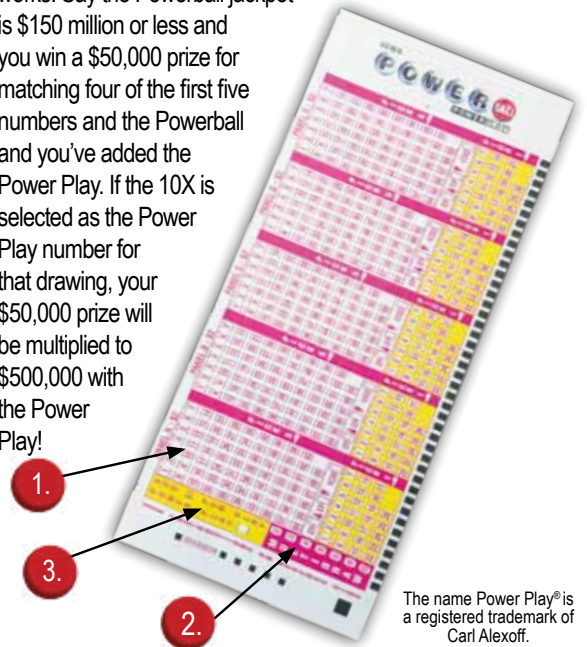

How to Play Mega Millions®

Mega Millions is a multi-state game; tickets are sold by 47 U.S. lotteries. Drawings are held at 10 p.m. on Tuesdays and Fridays. Tickets may be purchased in Iowa until 8:59 p.m. the evening of the drawing.

The starting jackpot and the rate at which the jackpot increases is based upon sales and interest rates, with no fixed minimums. Players have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim a prize.

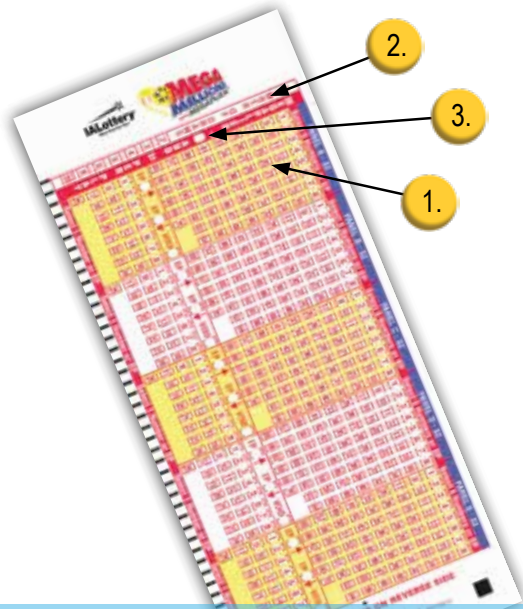

Lotto America is a multi-state game; tickets are sold by 13 U.S. lotteries. Drawings are held at 9:15 p.m. Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Tickets may be purchased in Iowa until 8:59 p.m. on the day of the drawing.

The starting jackpot and the rate at which the jackpot increases is based upon sales and interest rates, with no fixed minimums. Players have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim a prize.

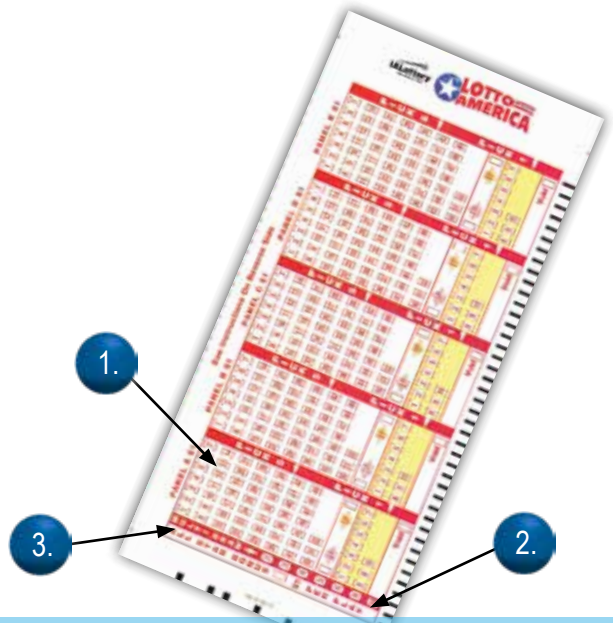

How to Play Lucky for Life®

Lucky for Life, THE GAME OF A LIFETIME®, is a multi-state game; tickets are sold by 23 U.S. lotteries. Drawings are held daily at 9:38 p.m. Tickets may be purchased in Iowa until 8:30 p.m. on the day of the drawing.

Win the top prize of \$1,000 a day for LIFE by matching all 5 white balls and the Lucky Ball. The game's second prize – for matching all five white balls without the Lucky Ball – is \$25,000 a year for LIFE. There are 8 other ways to win, so players should check their tickets after each drawing. Players have 180 days from the date of the drawing to claim a prize.

- Choose a set of three numbers, each from 0 through 9.

- Choose a set of four numbers, each from 0 through 9.

How to Win/Odds of Winning

- Use a play slip to choose your own numbers, request an “easy pick” from the clerk, or select “easy pick” on a lottery kiosk, and the lotto terminal or kiosk will choose the numbers for you. You can also do this using the LotteryPlus app (see Page 3). Play more than one drawing by marking the “Multi-draws” section on the play slip. Play up to 8 consecutive plays for either day or evening, or up to 16 consecutive plays for both day and evening.
- Select the play type:
 - Straight** - match all four numbers in the EXACT ORDER as drawn.
 - Box** - match all four numbers IN ANY ORDER.
 - Straight/Box** - match either exact and/or any order.
 - Front Pair** - match the first two numbers in the EXACT ORDER as drawn.
 - Back Pair** - match the last two numbers in the EXACT ORDER as drawn.
- The cost to play varies. 50¢ plays are available for Straight, Box, Front or Back Pairs. Play \$1, \$2, \$3, \$4 or \$5 for Straight, Box, Front or Back Pairs and Straight/Box.

How to Play InstaPlay



InstaPlay is an instant ticket that comes from the lotto terminal - it could be called a "scratchless scratch ticket." Experience lightning-fast play at your favorite retailer today!

Playing is fast and easy: You get InstaPlay games where you buy Powerball®, but they play like a scratch ticket. No waiting for a drawing to take place and no play slip to fill out - you can play immediately.

The cost to play ranges from \$1 to \$30, depending on the game selected. InstaPlay tickets are printed right at the Iowa Lottery terminal or kiosk when you buy them. Listen for the "cha-ching" sound at the terminal so you know your ticket was just printed.



Players have 90 days from the date of purchase to claim a prize.

You'll find easy play instructions on each InstaPlay ticket. Simply match your play numbers/symbols to see if you won. It's that simple!

About Progressive Games

- Some InstaPlay games offer a chance to win a progressive jackpot worth hundreds or even thousands of dollars
- For these games, the jackpot begins at a set minimum value then grows with each ticket sold until someone wins
- The actual jackpot amount that applies to your InstaPlay ticket will be listed at the top of your ticket
- In progressive games, a single ticket holder is awarded the entire jackpot, minus applicable taxes
- Remember that you can win other prizes besides the jackpot on progressive games, too, so be sure to check your ticket carefully

Prizes over \$600 may be claimed either by mail or by visiting an Iowa Lottery office. Prizes must be claimed within 90 days of the official game end date. You'll find plenty of games to choose from when you play pull-tabs. These games vary in price from 50 cents to \$5 and offer prizes ranging from 50 cents to \$2,000.

Claim Your Prize

You must sign your ticket before it can be checked or cashed. Pull-tab prizes up to \$600 must be redeemed at the same retailer where they were purchased. Prizes over \$600 may be claimed either by mail or by visiting an Iowa Lottery office. Prizes must be claimed within 90 days of the official game end date. Please Play Responsibly

If gambling becomes more than just a game for you or a loved one, help is available. There are treatment options statewide.

Responsible Gambling Awareness

Every year, the Iowa Lottery provides numerous reminders to the public about responsible play and how to find help if you or someone you know is being impacted by problem gambling.

From 1-800-BETS OFF messages printed on the back of every lottery ticket sold in Iowa, to stickers that are placed on lottery machines around the state and information that is available around the clock on the lottery website, the Iowa Lottery stresses the importance of social responsibility.

A Brief Gambling Screen:

During the past 12 months:

1. Have you become restless, irritable or anxious when trying to stop/cut down on gambling?
2. Have you tried to keep your family or friends from knowing how much you gambled?
3. Did you have such financial trouble as a result of your gambling that you had to get help with living expenses from family, friends or welfare?

If you answered "yes" to any of these questions, you may be at risk for developing a gambling problem.

Other Signs of Problem Gambling

- ▶ Gambling escalates, taking more risk to maintain excitement
 - ▶ Can't stop gambling when ahead
 - ▶ Gambling longer than you intended
 - ▶ Bet "over your head" and then "chase" losses
 - ▶ Miss work or other commitments because of gambling

How You Can Help A Friend, Family Member or Co-worker Who Has A Gambling Problem

- Do encourage them to get help
- Do offer to attend meetings with them
- Do take over finances
- Do confront the situation
- Don't deny the problem
- Don't bail them out
- Don't make excuses for them
- Don't blame yourself

Help Is Available In Our State

Help is available in Iowa if you or someone you know is being impacted by problem gambling. Iowa Problem Gambling Services offers individual, group and financial counseling for persons with gambling problems, family members and concerned others. All services are offered on a sliding fee scale through a statewide network of agencies.

You may also enroll in the lottery's statewide voluntary self-exclusion program. Download and print the most current version of the form from the lottery's website at ialottery.com. From the home page, use the link to the "Self-Exclusion Program" to find a link to the form. Visit any Iowa Lottery regional office and staff will assist you in obtaining and filling out the form. Forms are also available through Iowa Problem Gambling Services and may be notarized at local treatment providers if that service is available. When the form is completed and notarized, it should be returned to any Iowa Lottery regional office (listed on the back page).

Don't Forget Your Receipt

Remember to get a receipt every time you have a ticket checked or cashed at a lottery terminal in Iowa. It's an easy way to verify the results of your ticket and answer any questions you may have. You should first determine on your own whether your ticket has won a prize. But whenever you do have a ticket checked or cashed at a lottery terminal, receipts are available.

Double-Check Your Tickets

Double-check your lottery tickets when you buy them. Make sure a lotto ticket is for the game you want and that it contains the right numbers and drawings. Be sure the scratch coating is intact on a scratch ticket and that it covers the entire play area, including the "Scratch 2 Cash" area. For InstaPlay, double-check that the date and time the ticket was printed match when you purchased it. Make sure tickets from a vending machine come out as one ticket and not parts of two tickets. On pull-tabs be sure the perforations along the paper tabs have not been broken. And remember to always sign your ticket. That identifies the tickets – and any prizes you may win – as belonging to you!

Don't Fall For Lottery Scams

Scammers try their best to get your money, and one of the techniques they use involves impersonating lotteries. Remember, the only lottery that can operate in Iowa is the Iowa Lottery. And unless you specifically enter an Iowa Lottery promotion or contest, we will never contact you to inform you that you've won a prize.

Debit=OK, Credit=Don't Use

Debit cards can be used in Iowa to buy lottery tickets, but it's not OK to use a credit card for a lottery purchase in our state - our laws prohibit it. It's important to determine which kind of card you're thinking about using before you go forward with a lottery purchase.

Always sign your ticket!

ATTENTION PLAYERS: According to state law, credit cards may not be used to purchase lottery products. You are responsible for checking the accuracy of tickets before leaving the store and for determining whether or not a ticket is a winner! If you believe you have won and the terminal rejects, or a retailer disputes the validity of your prize claim, you may submit your claim directly to the Iowa Lottery for review. The Lottery recommends players use the following sources: check the lottery home page at ialottery.com; ask retailers to print winning numbers from the terminal; use the LotteryPlus mobile app; use the ticket self-checkers at retail locations; call Lottery offices (telephone numbers provided above); watch the televised drawing (if available); listen to results on local radio stations (if available); check results in local newspapers (if available). Sign the ticket before claiming. A parent or guardian must also sign the ticket for any claimant who is a minor. Iowa law prohibits the sale of lottery tickets to anyone under 21 years of age.
