Powerball® First Millionaire of the Year Promotion Rules

The Powerball First Millionaire of the Year Promotion is an Iowa Lottery VIP Club web-based promotion offering \$2,500 cash prizes. There will be 20 Iowa Lottery winners of a \$2,500 cash prize and those winners will be eligible to become a finalist for the Powerball First Millionaire of the Year drawing. The promotion, which can be entered by members of the VIP Club with eligible Powerball tickets, begins at 10:00 a.m. Central Time (CT) on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 and its entry period ends at 9:59 a.m. Tuesday, September 28, 2021. There will be one Iowa Lottery drawing on September 30 for the 20 winners of \$2,500. The Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) will conduct two drawings: one for the five finalists from all of the participating lotteries and another for the \$1 million winner. The Powerball First Millionaire of the Year will be announced in 2022, after the ball drop during the live broadcast of the Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve celebration.

The Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion prize is subject to lottery rules, validation procedures, offsets and deductions authorized by law.

Entry

Entrants must join or be a current member of the Iowa Lottery VIP Club and at least 21 years of age. Entry into the Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion is accomplished by legally acquiring and submitting an eligible Iowa Lottery Powerball ticket. Players can scan the eligible Powerball ticket to enter with the Iowa Lottery LotteryPlus app or visit the Iowa Lottery website at ialottery.com and enter the Powerball ticket number located on the front of the ticket.

Powerball ticket sales eligible for the promotion will begin at the start of business on September 1, 2021 and continue through 9:59 a.m., Tuesday, September 28, 2021. Players may enter multiple tickets, but an eligible Powerball ticket can be entered only once. Each Powerball ticket entered with a value of \$2 or more will receive one entry in the promotion regardless of the number of Powerball plays on the ticket or the ticket value. All entries are final. Entrants must follow the VIP Club rules. Players must use a street address for their account information – P.O. boxes are not valid for this promotion or the VIP Club. Entry of a Powerball ticket into the Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion is sufficient for presentation of a ticket for validation purposes for this promotion. Players will need to keep their Powerball ticket to claim any cash prize won in a multi-state Powerball drawing held on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday evenings.

Eligibility

An eligible entry is any legally acquired Iowa Lottery Powerball ticket dated September 1, 2021 through 9:59 a.m. September 28, 2021 that has not been previously submitted as an entry into this promotion on the Lottery website or the Iowa Lottery LotteryPlus app. Winning and nonwinning Iowa Lottery Powerball tickets are eligible for entry in the promotion. Except as provided under the "CEO's Discretion" herein below, an eligible entry is one in which the entry information is completed and submitted electronically during the posted entry time as specified on the Iowa Lottery website. An eligible \$2 or more Powerball ticket may be entered only once. Each ticket entered will receive one entry regardless of the price of the ticket or the number of plays on the ticket. Players may attempt to enter or submit up to 40 total unique entries per day in a VIP Club account. Each attempt of ticket submission counts as one entry attempt. The Iowa Lottery is not responsible for otherwise eligible entries that are entered inaccurately, incorrectly, or arrive after 9:59 a.m. CT Tuesday, September 28, 2021. All entrants must be 21 years of age or older. A person can only win one \$2,500 cash prize.

Players who have signed up for the Iowa Lottery self-exclusion program are not eligible to participate in this promotion. Members of the Iowa Lottery Board of Directors and Iowa Lottery employees and their immediate families, as defined by statute, are not eligible. Further, officers, employees, agents, or subcontractors of any vendor who have access to confidential information that may compromise the integrity of the Lottery, and their immediate families, as defined by statute, are not eligible.

Drawing

There will be one Iowa Lottery drawing held on September 30 for the 20 winners of a \$2,500 cash prize. The drawing will be held in accordance with the schedule posted to the Lottery's website (ialottery.com) and listed in the rules. The drawing will be held under the supervision of an independent auditor. All drawings of the Iowa Lottery are public events and the Lottery will comply with any public health directives in effect at the time of these drawings. Persons interested in observing drawings are invited to receive detailed information by contacting the Iowa Lottery Security Division in Des Moines at 515/725-7900; TTY Relay Iowa at 800/735-2942; or by email directed to WMaster@ialottery.com. A request to observe a drawing must be received by the Lottery no later than seven days in advance of the drawing. All drawings are recorded.

The winners' names will be posted on the Lottery's website by the end of the day following the draw day or as soon as available. Each selected winner will be sent an email to his or her VIP Club member email address. Entrants are not required to personally attend the drawing or be present at the time of the drawing to be determined a winner. Each of the selected numbers will be verified against the numbers entered in the promotion. A sufficient number of entries will be randomly selected to ensure there are valid winners for the prizes to be announced.

The prize winners in the Iowa Lottery Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion drawing must complete and sign a winner claim form along with appropriate tax documentation and present those documents with a legible copy of their government-issued photo identification to the Iowa Lottery within 15 business days after the draw date to claim their prize. The winners must present the completed documents at any Iowa Lottery regional office open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., by the Iowa Lottery's digital promotion prize claim process, or by mail to the Iowa Lottery headquarters office at 13001 University Avenue, Clive, IA 50325. Lottery offices are closed on state holidays.

If a valid winner does not present a fully executed claim form and the appropriate documents to the Lottery by 4:00 p.m. CT 15 business days after the draw date, the prize package will be awarded to the first eligible alternate in the order they were drawn. If an alternate(s) is required for the prize package, an email notification will be sent to the alternate's VIP Club email address and their name will be posted on the Lottery website. If an alternate(s) is required for the prize package, they must present a fully executed winner claim form and required documents to the Iowa Lottery by 4:00 p.m. CT 15 business days from the date the winner's name is posted to the lottery website.

By submitting an entry into the Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion and claiming the prize, the entrant certifies they are the sole owner of the entry, the entrant is at least 21 years old, the ticket is not stolen, and the entrant is not disqualified from receiving a prize. By entering the promotion, the entrant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the State of Iowa and the Iowa Lottery, its elected officials, apprentices, employees, agents and volunteers. In consideration for participating in the promotion, the entrant waives any and all claims the entrant may have or ever claim to have against the Iowa Lottery, its employees, agents, or board members, relating in any way to the promotion. The player also consents to the use by the Lottery of their name and/or likeness for advertising, trade or promotional purposes without further compensation.

By accepting a Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion prize, the winner and their heirs, legal representatives, and assigns agree to indemnify, defend, release, and discharge the Iowa Lottery; State of Iowa; and each of their employees, officers and directors from and against any loss, claim damage, suit or injury arising out of or relating to the promotion or any action taken pursuant to these rules. The Iowa Lottery and the State of Iowa are not responsible or liable, in any way, for any personal injuries, illness, death, property damage, or other damages or expense resulting from or arising out of acceptance, fulfillment, use or misuse of the promotion prize or any element thereof.

Each of the 20 Iowa Lottery winners will be eligible to be 1 of the 5 finalists for the MUSL Powerball First Millionaire of the Year drawing. Five finalists from all participating lotteries will receive a "Celebrate@Home" New Year's Eve party package with a retail value of \$20,000. The "Celebrate@Home" New Year's Eve package will provide the 5 finalists with all of the necessities and more to throw an epic New Year's Eve celebration at home and to participate remotely as 1 of the 5 finalists in the Powerball First Millionaire of the Year drawing for a \$1 Million cash prize, which will occur shortly after midnight.

The Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) will conduct two drawings: one for the five finalists from all of the participating lotteries and another for the \$1 million winner. The Powerball First Millionaire of the Year will be announced in 2022, after the ball drop during the live broadcast of the Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve celebration.

The "Celebrate@ Home" package includes a \$10,000 cash prize, a deluxe surf and turf dinner for eight from Omaha Steaks, 70-inch LED TV, a karaoke system, premium 15.5-inch laptop computer with 20 megapixel digital camera, on-camera microphone, 19-inch ring light, \$500 Party City gift card and gift bags.

Odds

The odds of winning a Powerball First Millionaire of the Year promotion prize will vary depending on the number of entries.

Iowa Lottery CEO's Discretion

If the CEO, or the CEO's designee, determines that an otherwise valid entry has been foiled by the intervention of a Lottery employee, Lottery retailer or Lottery vendor processing error, the CEO may authorize the replacement of an eligible entry. This shall be the player's only recourse against the Lottery or its personnel.

Force Majeure

If the Iowa Lottery is hindered from providing the prizes due to riots, acts of God, shortages of labor or materials, a pandemic, war, acts of terrorism, governmental laws, regulations or restrictions or any other causes of any kind whatsoever which are beyond the reasonable control of the Iowa Lottery, the Iowa Lottery shall not be liable or responsible for its inability to provide some or all of the prizes discussed herein.

Choice of Law and Forum

The laws of the State of Iowa shall govern and determine all matters arising out of or in connection with this promotion. Any and all litigation commenced in connection with this promotion shall be brought and maintained solely in Polk County District Court for the State of Iowa, Des Moines, Iowa, or in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Iowa, Central Division, Des Moines, Iowa, wherever jurisdiction is appropriate. This provision shall not be construed as waiving any immunity in state or federal court, which may be available to the Lottery or the State of Iowa.

Technical Disclaimer

The Iowa Lottery is not responsible for and shall not be liable for:

- Any damage to an entrant's computer system or device that is directly or indirectly caused by accessing or downloading content from <https://www.ialottery.com> or otherwise participating in this promotion; or
- Any computer system, phone line, hardware, software, cell phone, application, or program malfunctions; or
- Other errors, failures, dropped or delayed computer transmissions or network connections that are human or technical in nature.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Iowa Lottery is not responsible for incomplete, illegible, misdirected, late, lost, damaged or stolen entries; or for lost, interrupted, inaccessible or unavailable networks, satellites, Internet Service Providers (ISP), website or other connections; or for miscommunications; failed, jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected computer, telephone or cable transmission; or for any technical malfunctions, failures or difficulties; printing errors; clerical, typographical or other error in the offering or announcement of any prize or in any prize notification documents, or other errors of any kind or nature; or for the incorrect or inaccurate capture of information or the failure to capture information.
